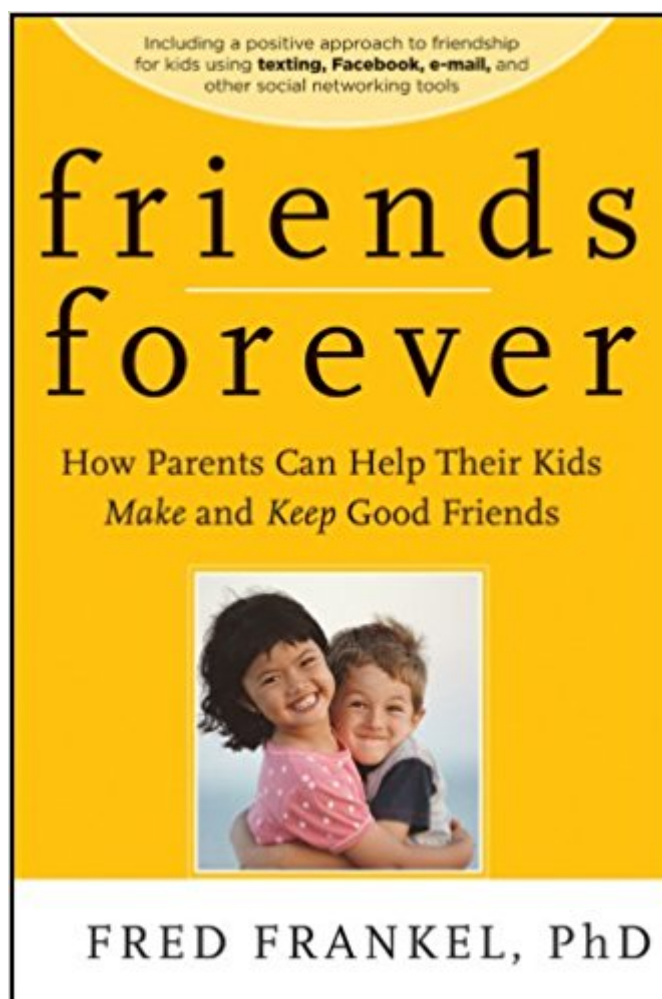

It encourages parents to train kids so they can make their own friends and solve their own problems. The book helps with ways to support your child, but doesn't make you think you're supposed to do everything for them. This is a great book for any parent, but especially helpful if your kid is struggling and you're looking for a better way to help.
