For me this isn't Vella's best work and I normally like her books. This one started out with a thrilling opening, but after that the main female and male protagonist fell flat. I never felt James and Eden's emotional connection, and the emotional angst felt contrived and it was followed by a lot of talk and no emotional depth. I was also perplexed by Vella using modern language and mannerism in the Regency romance with a dash of paranormal. I loved the premise but the execution was not what I have come to expect from the author. I understood she wanted to set the Sinclair's as unique but their reactions and actions truly seemed over the top considering the time period.

I am a huge fan of Wendy Vella's and was so excited to find a new series by her! The lives of James, Duke of Raven and Eden Sinclair were bound years before their meeting. Like her siblings, Eden is blessed or cursed, depending on how you look at it, with a heightened sense. It is this sense that helps with her saving the Duke's life.
