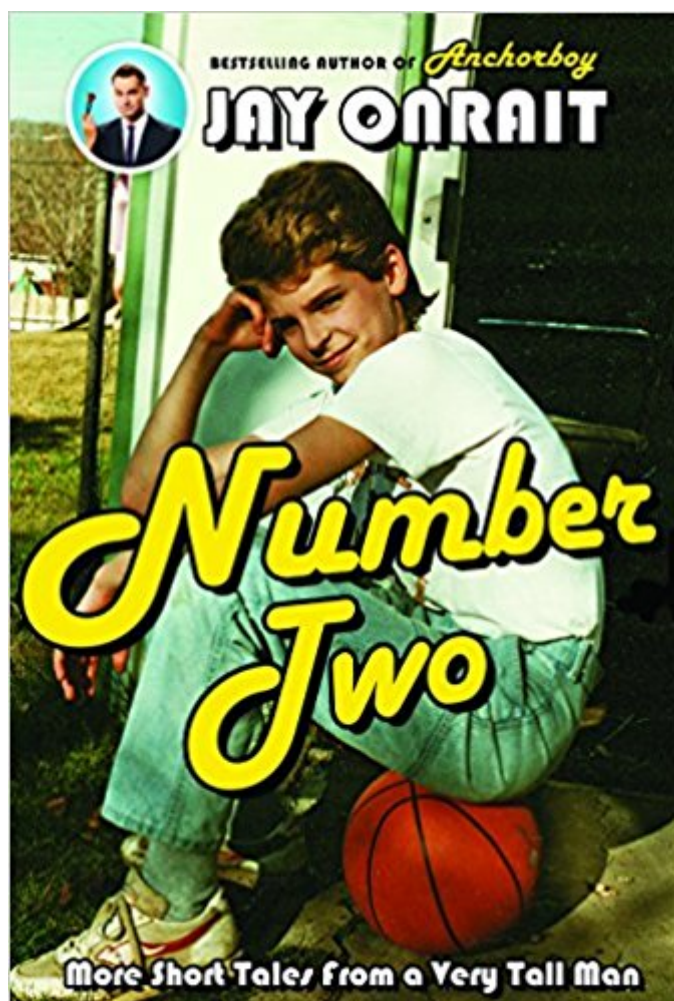


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# Number Two: More Short Tales From A Very Tall Man
